Emergency Management helps to protect communities by coordinating activities necessary to build, sustain, and improve the capability to mitigate against, prepare for, respond to, and recover from threatened or actual disasters.

Our Mission Statement

The mission of the Emergency Management program is to provide students effective instruction and essential skills to prepare them with a foundation of technical and professional knowledge needed for emergency services delivery in local, state, and federal government agencies.

Students in the Emergency Management program will be able to (1) identify the four phases of emergency management: mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery, and (2) describe an “all-hazards” approach.

The Emergency Management Program is an online program that can be completed in as little as two years. The course of study involves both management and technical aspects of law enforcement, fire protection, emergency medical services, and emergency management.
