CRRSAA / ARP Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants

Caldwell Community College and Technical Institute (CCC&TI) signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the US Department of Education offering assurance that the college intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students on April 17, 2020.

The college received a Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) Grant Award Notification from the US Department of Education on January 17, 2021, in the amount of \$876,735 for Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants and accepted the terms and conditions as outlined.

Status of Distribution of Funds

As of March 31, 2021, Caldwell Community College & Technical Institute has distributed zero dollars in CRRSAA/HEERF II Emergency Financial Aid Grants funds under Section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSAA.

Eligibility

For the Spring 2021 term, it is estimated that 622 students are to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965.
