

Temporary Medical Conditions or Injuries

Students with a temporary impairment may be eligible to receive accommodations and services on a temporary basis. Disability Services works with students who experience significant limitations due to temporary conditions such as illness, injury, surgery, etc. We can assist with contacting instructors, providing physical access, and classroom assistance.

Students who are experiencing a temporary disability should contact the Disability Services representative on the campus where they are attending classes as soon as possible. Students are encouraged to discuss the impact, duration, and functional limitations of the temporary condition.

The student will be expected to provide medical documentation including a diagnosis, expected duration of condition, treatment, and limitations. Hospital discharge summaries or doctor's notes often provide the necessary information. Individuals are encouraged to meet and discuss impact, duration and functional limitations of the temporary impairment.
