Credentialing Examination Pass Rate

Type of Data: Five-year average pass rate on credentialing examination

given by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists.

Benchmark: 75% or higher will pass the national registry on their first attempt within six months of graduation.

Job Placement Rate

Type of Data: Number of graduates employed in radiography within 12 months of graduation that are actively seeking employment.

The JRCERT has defined "not actively seeking employment" as:

- 1.) Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment
- 2.) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation
- 3.) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours
- 4.) Graduate is on active military duty
- 5.) Graduate is continuing their education

Benchmark: 75% or higher of graduates will be employed in radiography within six months of graduation.
