

NURSE AIDE REFRESHER

Nurse Aide III Refresher is a 20 hour course that provides students with an expired Nurse Aide I listing the opportunity to update their Nurse Aide I knowledge of personal care and basic nursing assistant skills through written materials and lab practice.

Out of state individuals who present proof of completion of a state approved Nurse Aide I course, who want to be listed in North Carolina, may also register for this course.

A certificate of course completion will be presented upon successful completion of the course requirements. In order to become listed or re-listed as a Nurse Aide I with the state of North Carolina and satisfy requirements imposed by the Division of Health Service Regulation, the student must successfully pass a two part written and skills state administered examination. A minimum fee of \$96 must be submitted to NACES in addition to the application and course completion certificate.

Q&A:

- **What is the length of the course?**
 - 20 hours
- **What are the entrance requirements?**
 - Proof of completion of a minimum 75-hour state approved Nurse Aide I course
 - Written proof of expired Nurse Aide I listing within the past 2 years
 - Documented proof of any name change
 - Social Security card
 - State issued photo I.D.
- **What are the costs for the course and supplies?**
 - Registration fee is \$65
- **How do I become re-listed as a Nurse Aide I in North Carolina?**
 - The student must successfully pass the state-administered written and skills competency evaluation given at a regional testing site.
- **How do I go about that?**
 - The student will submit an application and examination fee of \$96 to NACES Plus Foundation to be scheduled for the examination as required by the Division of Health Service Regulation.
- **Where do I test?**
 - There are a number of test sites located throughout NC. The Regional Test Sites can be found on the North Carolina Nurse Aide page of the Pearson VUE website: (www.pearsonvue.com). CCC&TI is not a regional test site.
