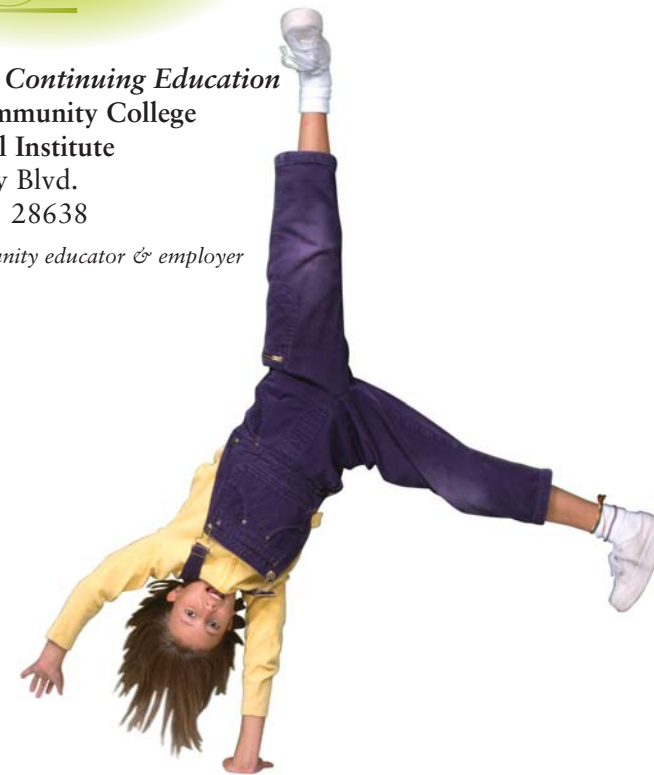

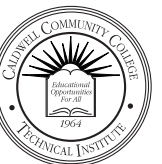

## Destination Science

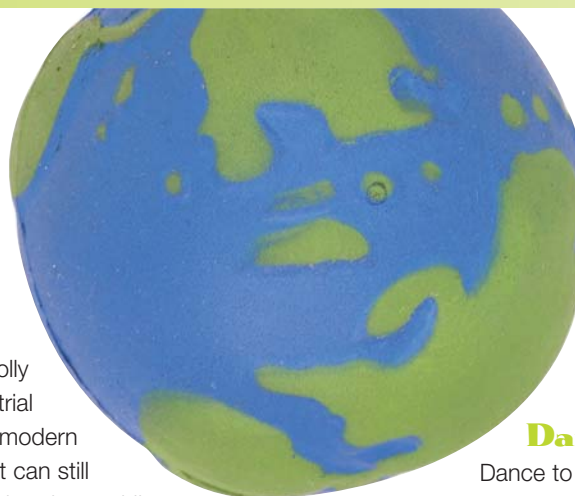
July 19 - July 23 Ages 8 & up only

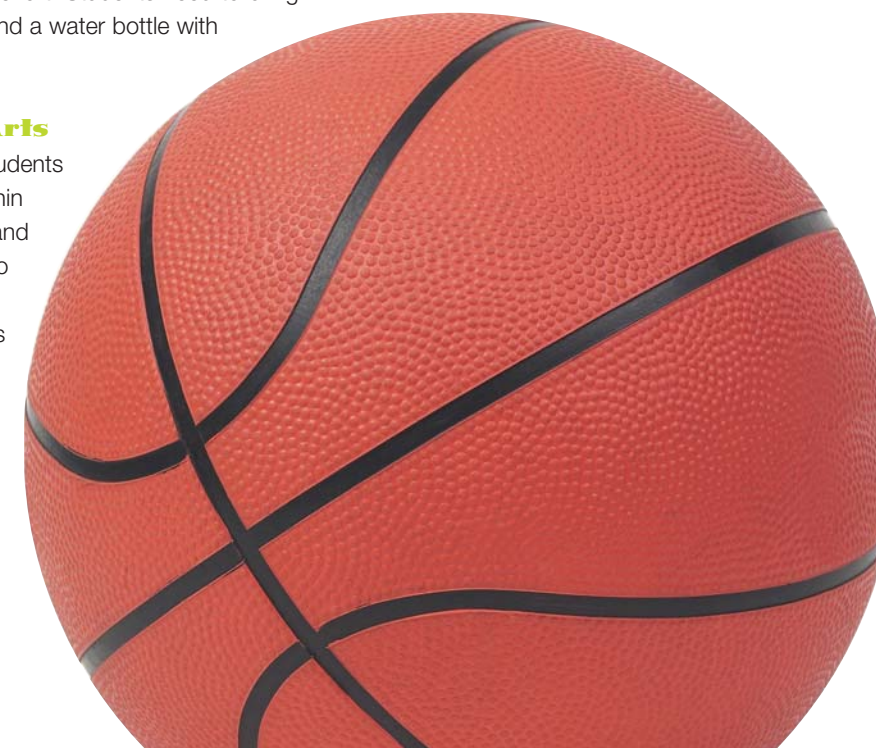
August 2 - August 6

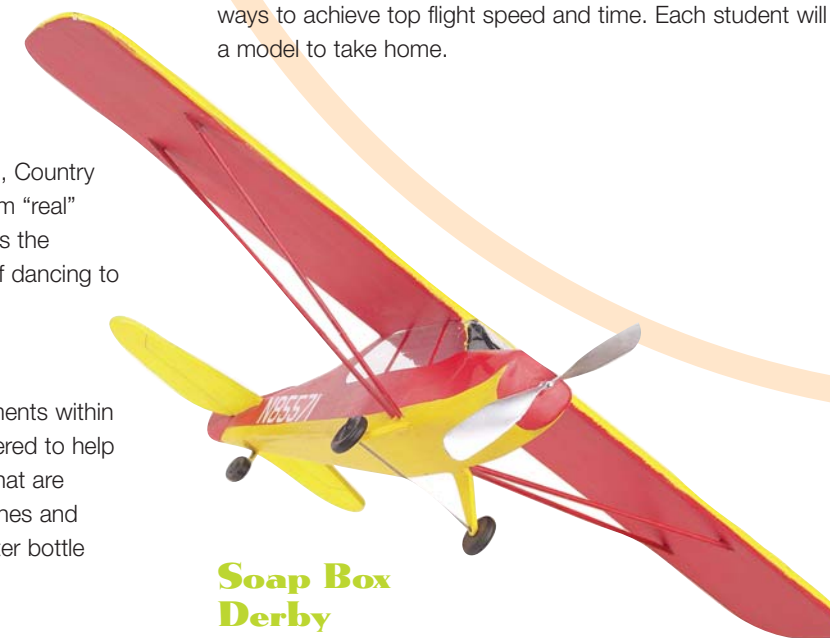


## Speed Camp
